Looking toward the future, please mark your calendars and remind your neighbors of the upcoming Kindergarten Registration Day on Thursday, April 20, 2017. The registration will be held in the school gymnasium during the hours of 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM. Children who will be 5 years old by September 30, 2017, can start kindergarten in the fall. To register, parents need to bring the following items: the child's birth certificate and two proofs of residency in the Laurel Meadow attendance zone (one being a deed or a lease). The parent or guardian should bring a photo ID on registration day. Before the child can begin school in the fall, a School Entrance Health Form must be completed by a physician. You can complete the School Enrollment Forms by going to the Hanover County website and downloading the registration forms at www.hanover.k12.va.us. We are looking forward to meeting our new Laurel Meadow Lions.

Another important event in April is the Laurel Meadow Field Day. Grades 3-5 have their field day on Thursday, April 27th, and Grades k-2 have field day on Friday, April 28th. We are hoping for perfect weather on those two days.
