# **Curriculum Update:**

Hanover County Public Schools offers a compacted curriculum in mathematics for some fourth and fifth grade students. Third grade students meeting the criteria for the compacted 4/5 grade class will be taught the entire fourth grade Math Standards of Learning and portions of the fifth grade standards. At the end of the year (next school year only) these students will take the fourth grade portion of the Math SOL Assessment. Students who are currently in the 4/5 compacted math class and meet the criteria for 5/6 math will take the grade 6 SOL next Spring.

The school theme next year will continue to be "Lights, Camera, Learning."


