Supporting the PTA

How great is it to know that every dollar you donate to the school will go right back to the teachers and students right here at Laurel Meadow Elementary School? Here are a few programs the PTA supports throughout the year using the funds raised through events like No-selling November and our Read-a-Thon which we will be hosting in late Jan., early Feb, watch for more details to come. By not using a third-party company to sell products, we are able to use all the money you give to programs that support the students in our school. Here are a few examples: Reflections Awards and Prizes, Speech, Math Coach, Music, Reading Specialist, Art, Specialized Instruction (SPED), the Gifted and Talented program, and so much more.

During the planning period and in the midst of the coronavirus preparations, Principal Davis retracted his ask for supplemental reading program materials. This comes as a result from being unable to safely hold the Boosterthon and benefit from the funds raised during that event. In 2018, we brought in almost \$20,000 for our school and even more in 2019. This year looks a little different because of the Covid-19 Pandemic and we, the PTA, are trying to make the most of the situation. Our goal is to continue to find funds to support the OWL students and teachers, the in-school teachers and specialized programs our school offers to the kids at LMES, and find the funds for Principal Davis for the Supplemental Reading Program. We know this is a big ask, and we can only do this with continued help from you all.

Gifted Referrals

How can students be referred for gifted screening and what makes a good candidate?

A teacher or a parent may refer a child for gifted screening. If your child exhibits gifted behaviors and is performing at above grade level expectations, your child's teachers may refer them as a good candidate for the screening process.

Parents may also refer students for gifted testing. Please discuss your child's performance with their teachers, as they will have insight into gifted characteristics and above level benchmarks. If you would like to refer your child for testing to determine if they would be eligible for gifted services, please submit your request to your child's teacher no later than January 31st for the Spring Testing Window. The deadline for all signed permission slips is January 31, 2021.
