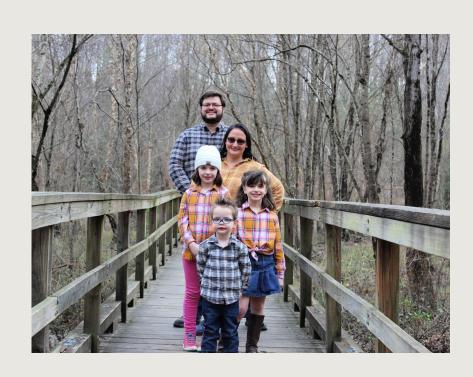


#### Meet your 2022-2023 PTA Executive Team

She enjoys working at her church, travel, and binge watching Netflix and Discovery Plus.

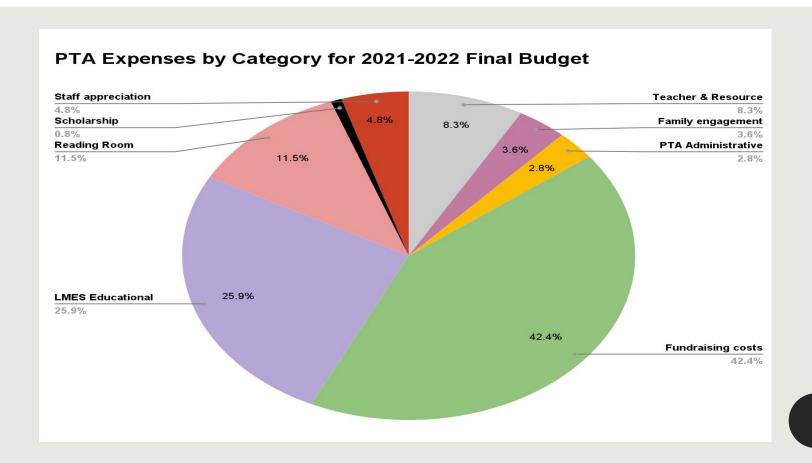
